ENGLISH ANCESTRY

FRANCISCUS DENISON of HOUGHTON, now Glass Houghton in Yorkshire, England, a member of the family of Denison of Great Woodhouse, near Leeds, married Mary, his wife, and settled at CASTLEFORD, four miles from Leeds, in the year 1706. At the Church of All Saints at Castleford, are registered the baptisms of their children: Anne, June 2, 1707; William, Oct. 5, 1708; Francis, Jan. 5, 1711; Mary, Mar. 3, 1713 to Mar. 13, 1713; John, baptised Mar. 3, 1713, of whom the Hooyaart Denisons; George, June 24, 1716, who was the father of Captain John Denison of Early Canada; and David, Dec. 13, 1719.

GEORGE DENISON of HEDON, born at Castleford, 1716, married at Trawby-Brigg Chapel, in the Church of St. Mary, Trawby, Lincolnshire, by licence, May 14, 1752, Mary Parkinson, who was born at Burringham, Lincolnshire, 1733. They lived at Hedon, Yorkshire, on a farm called "Stockholm", 3 mile south of Hedon, off the road to Thorngumbald. At St. Augustine's Church, Hedon, were baptised their following children: George, June 17, 1753, died at Rotherham, June 3, 1810, where a memorial exists to his memory;

JOHN DENISON of EARLY CANADA, Nov. 27, 1755 to Oct. 28, 1824, married at St. Nicholas Church, Harwich, Dec. 19, 1782, Sophia Taylor, born, Harwich, Oct. 13, 1765, died, Quebec, Lower Canada, Nov. 26, 1852. OF THIS MARRIAGE proceeds THE CANADIAN PIONEER DENISON FAMILY; Thomas Denison, June 9, 1757, who married thirdly Margaret Hales.

He was a doctor who lived in London, England. He left the greater part of his independent fortune to Rev. John Dixon Hales of St. John's Church, Richmond, Surrey, a nephew by marriage; David Denison, Mar. 27, 1763, died in infancy, buried May 1, 1763.

Genealogy of the Canadian Pioneer Denisons of Early and Later Toronto, Canada:

Captain John and Sophia (Taylor) Denison, above mentioned had the following children:

1. Colonel George Taylor Denison, born at Dovercourt, Harwich, Essex, England, Dec. 29, 1783, and baptised at St. Nicholas Church, Harwich, died at Old Bellevue, Toronto, Dec. 18, 1853. He had four wives, as follows:

(a) married firstly Dec. 18, 1806 at Richmond Hill, Upper Canada, Esther Borden Lippincott, who was born after a ship-wreck in which her mother nearly drowned, July 14, 1791, and who died Apr. 13, 1823. She was a daughter of Captain Richard Lippincott, a United Empire Loyalist. (b) married secondly, Sept. 1, 1827 at London, England, his first cousin, Maria Taylor, who was born at Dovercourt, Essex, Aug. 9, 1794, and who died at Old Bellevue, York, Upper Canada, Feb. 2, 1831. (c) married thirdly at St. James' Cathedral, York, U.C., Mar. 4, 1833, Mrs. Elizabeth Eleanor Caldwell Todd, a widow, who was born in Ireland, Nov. 30, 1802, and who died at Old Bellevue, York, U.C., Apr. 6, 1849. She was daughter of John and Eleanor Caldwell; (d) married fourthly at St. George's Church, York, U.C., June 29, 1850, Maria Priscilla Coates, who was born in London, England, June 10, 1807, and who died at Old Bellevue, May 6, 1887. She was a daughter of William and Susanna Coates. (Sophia Denison in her diary spells the name Coats.)

2. Captain Thomas John Denison, born at Dovercourt, England, Nov. 1, 1786, died at York, U.C., Aug. 23, 1846, married at St. James Cathedral, Mar. 4, 1817, Maria Pillion Lawrence, who was born at St. John, N.B., Aug. 26, 1794, and who died at Toronto, Oct. 31, 1880. OF THIS MARRIAGE proceeds THE WESTON BRANCH.

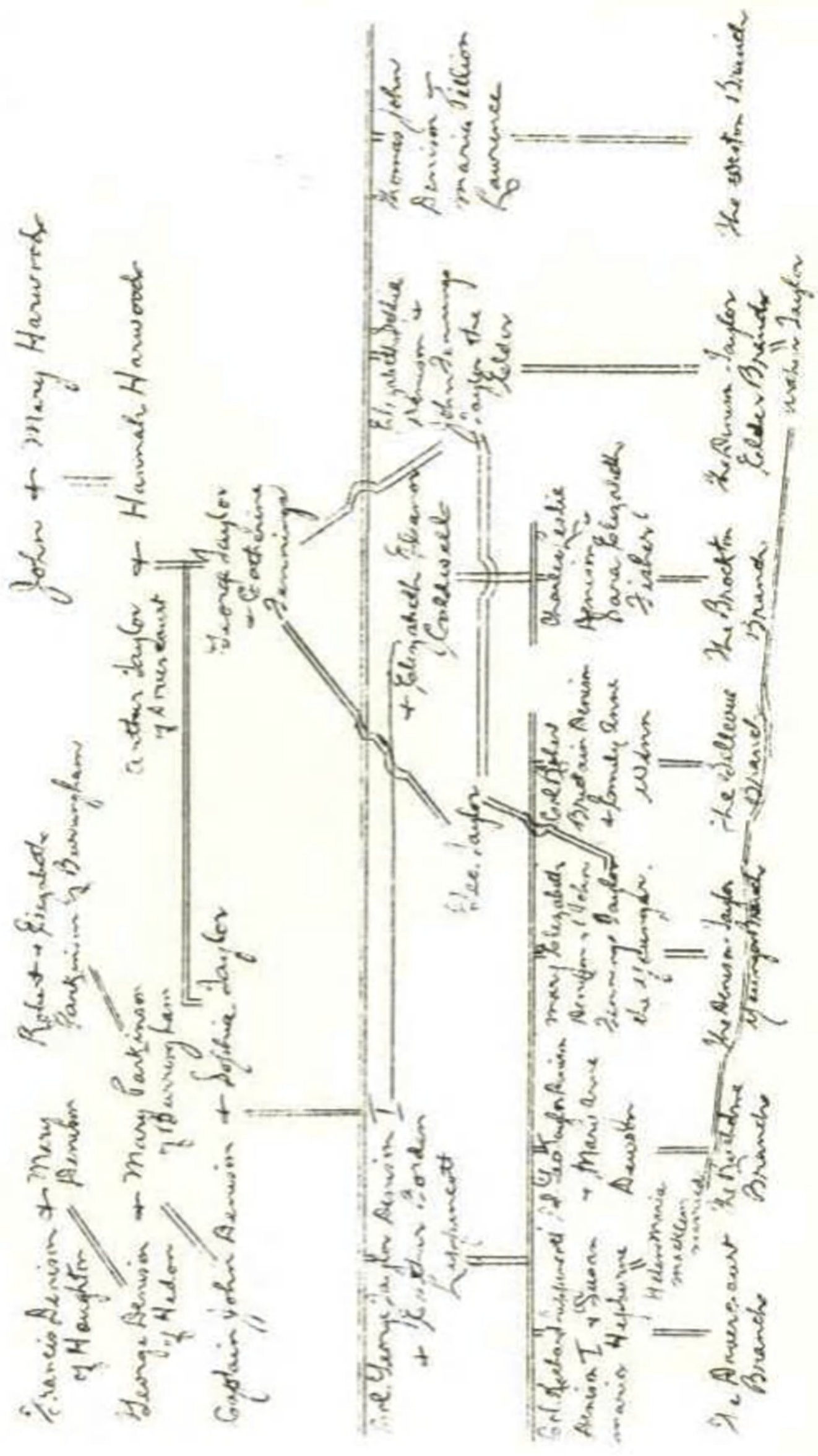
3. Charles Denison, born at Dovercourt, England, 1789, died at York, U.C., Aug. 15, 1820, Will dated Mar. 30, 1832. No Issue.

4. John Denison, born in Upper Canada, 1796, died at York, U.C., Jan. 5, 1826. No issue. He was the first Denison to be born in Canada.

5. Elizabeth Denison, born Yonge and Front Streets, York, U.C., Nov. 2, 1800, died Oct. 14, 1801.

6. Elizabeth Sophia Denison (Betsy), born Weston, Sept. 28, 1803, died Ottawa, Jan. 14, 1892, married June 25, 1828, at Brookfield House, Toronto, her first cousin, John Fennings Taylor, born Dovercourt, England, Jan. 26, 1801, died Ottawa, Dec. 18, 1876. He was a son of George Taylor, 1762 to 1812 of Dovercourt, England, by his wife, Catherine Fennings, youngest daughter of Captain Fennings, privateersman, George Taylor was son of Arthur & Hannah (Harwood) Taylor, and was brother of Sophia Taylor. OF THIS MARRIAGE proceeds the DENISON-TAYLOR the ELDER BRANCH.

The Borden and the Lippincotts who lived at Bordentown, New Jersey. 2.
 The following is from the old Lippincott Family Bible: Joseph Borden, the original Borden, born 1686, died 1765. "He gave the Chalkley Ground for a meeting-place." He married Ann 1686--1744. They had a son, Thomas Borden, who died Sept. 28, 1764, who also had a son, Jeremiah Borden, who founded Bordentown in New Jersey, and who was born July 1, 1711, and who died at Bordentown, N.J., Aug. 5, 1754, and who married Esther Tilton. Their children were as follows: 1. Esther Borden, born Mar. 10, 1747 and who died young; 2. Rebekah Borden, born Mar. 2, 1749; 3. Jeremiah Borden, born Dec. 30, 1750, died at Bordentown, Sept. 9, 1777; 4. Samuel Borden, born Nov. 10, 1752, died at Bordentown, Sept. 11, 1777; 5. Colonel George Taylor Denison the Second of Rusholme, born June 17, 1816, died at Rusholme, May 30, 1873, married at St. James' Cathedral, Dec. 11, 1838, Mary Anne Dawson, who was born at Enniscorthy, Wexford, Ireland, May 24, 1817, and who died Sept. 25, 1900, daughter of Major Jeremiah Dawson, and Elizabeth Kinsey. The Dawsens were present at the famous ball given in Brussels by the Duchess of Richmond, just before the Battles of Quatre Bras and Waterloo, the ball about which Lord Byron wrote the famous poem. OF THIS MARRIAGE proceeds THE RUSHOLME BRANCH.

7. Mary Elizabeth Denison, born Aug. 26, 1818, died at Rusholme, Apr. 4, 1851, married Dec. 5, 1838, John Pennings Taylor the Younger. OF THIS MARRIAGE proceeds THE DENISON-TAYLOR the YOUNGER BRANCH.

8. Colonel Robert Brittain Denison, born Apr. 24, 1821, died Aug. 4, 1900, married firstly May 14, 1845, Emily Anne Winn at St. James' Cathedral. She was born Apr. 10, 1822, and died Apr. 4, 1867, daughter of John Horace Winn of London, England. Denison married secondly Sept. 5, 1870, Eliza, daughter of Joseph Steere Browne. OF THIS FIRST MARRIAGE proceeds THE BELLEVUE BRANCH.

He was accidentally fatally shot by his brother Charles in an unfortunate accident after school.

13. Charles Leslie Denison, Aug. 20, 1841 to Apr. 24, 1919, married firstly Oct. 8, 1863 Margaret Ann Coates, at Brooklyn, Long Island. They broke up, but were later remarried at Dovercourt, Dec. 22, 1875 by Rev. Dr. String. She died Feb. 1, 1880, and he married secondly Sara Elizabeth Fisher, Aug. 12, 1850 to Jan. 4, 1919. OF THIS SECOND MARRIAGE proceeds THE BROCKTON BRANCH.

Lanty Shannon.

Lanty Shannon lived at Muddy Run Farm, Stanford, which is about 200 feet from a bridge over a small creek or "run" at the Portage Road which led from Queenston to Chippewa. The house was burned. (See Lundy Genealogy, by Lilly B. Lundy Pool.) Muddy Run Farm House was on lot 113, Township of Stanford, west side of Portage Road, one mile from the Village of Niagara.

Lanty Shannon emigrated from Ireland, 1792, at the age of 22, to New Jersey. He arrived in Canada in 1800. He stood six feet tall, was straight and active, clean-shaven, and an enjoyable companion. He lies buried in Drummond Hill Presbyterian Cemetery, Lundy's Lane, Niagara Falls, Ontario.

Lanty Shannon, born in Ireland, Oct. 28, 1770, died Aug. 4, 1846, married his cousin, Agnes Shannon, on Apr. 17, 1792. She was born Apr. 8, 1773, and died Dec. 23, 1857.

1. Susan Shannon, born in Philadelphia, Sept. 20, 1799, died Aug. 3, 1835, married at Muddy Run Farm, May 15, 1817, William Hepburne, June 1791 to Mar. 10, 1855, son of William George Hepburne and Eliza Ingram. William Hepburne was postmaster at Chippewa. He married secondly Margaret-----, who died Nov. 1, 1838, aged 38 years, 6 months and 27 days.

2. Nancy Shannon, Dec. 10, 1801 to Oct. 12, 1828, married David Lynch.

William and Susan Shannon Hepburne had the following children:

1. Susan Maria Hepburne, who married Col. Richard Lippincott Denison the First.
2. Ann Eliza Hepburne, born at Chippewa, Jan. 18, 1821, married at St. James' Cathedral, Toronto, July 19, 1842, William Anthony Rooth, a Collector of Customs at Port Colborne.

1. William Hepburne Rooth, who married Julia Macklem Taylor, see the Denison-Taylor the Elder Branch.
3. Jane Hepburne, born at Chippewa, July 13, 1824, died July 23, 1824.

All early records, including tombstones at Drummond Hill Cemetery, spell the name Hepburne. Later generations, however, have preferred the spelling Hepbourne, and a street in Toronto, named after the family, is spelled in that manner.

According to Lundy Genealogy, by Lilly B. Lundy Pool, Lanty Shannon was a descendant of the famous Drake family, tracing back to the illustrious Sir Francis.

NOTE

The foregoing pages are a complete and accurate genealogical record of all the descendants of Captain John Denison and Sophia Taylor, his wife, who with their three sons, George Taylor, Thomas John, and Charles, came to Canada in the year 1792, and settled at what is now the city of Toronto, when it was being first surveyed from the primeval wilderness. The basis of this genealogical record was the information in the fly-leaves of the two Family Bibles which were at St. George's Chapel, Dovercourt, the one on the altar, the other on the lectern. These Bible records were in the possession of my aunt, Mrs. Minnie Boyd of Bobcaygeon, Ont. I copied them out longhand in 1931, when I was on a visit at her home. To these I added all the information I could discover in printed books on the subject. In 1943, I began to try to locate the whereabouts of all known descendants, making full use of all directories which I could find. Each descendant located gave no clues to others, and finally I discovered almost all descendants. In September of 1951, I produced the first copies of this record, and placed them in the hands of the various descendants of the family. As a result, many letters reached me, containing corrections and much additional information. All this was placed on separate insert sheets, which were supplied to those who had copies. When the original supply ran out, I decided to re-type the stencils and include all information in its proper order. The final result is this volume which is as near perfect as I have been able to make it. This volume is the first of a series of which three volumes have been so far completed, the other two being historical and biographical. Please send me any additional information.
